## DRAWING, PAINTING, 3D and PRINTING

Show patterns and textures in drawing by adding dots and lines  
Mix paints to make secondary colours  
Add black and white to paints to make tints and tones  
Make own printing blocks using different materials  
Make prints of two or more colours  
Experiment with making life size models  
Learn about great artists, architects, craft makers and designers, and understand the historical and cultural development of their art forms.  
Keep a sketch book to record, review and revisit

## DRAWING, PAINTING TEXTILES and COLLAGE

Use a viewfinder as a tool when sketching  
Use watercolours to create background washes  
Create mood and feeling using colours  
Use cross stitch and back stitch  
Learn the basics of quilting, padding and gathering  
Create collage using paper and other materials  
Use mosaic, montage, coiling and overlapping  
Use ceramic mosaic techniques  
Learn about great artists, architects, craft makers and designers, and understand the historical and cultural development of their art forms.

## DRAWING, PAINTING, 3D and PRINTING

Use simple perspective in their work using a single focal point and horizon  
Use shading to create different effects  
Mix colours to recreate those I have seen  
Work with complementary colours  
Use paper techniques e.g. origami and pop ups  
Use recycled, natural and man made materials to create sculptures  
Sculpt in clay and papier-mache  
Develop skills in using clay : slabs, coils, slips  
make precise repeating patterns with print blocks  
Learn about great artists, architects, craft makers and designers, and understand the historical and cultural development of their art forms.

Combine different materials to good effect when drawing  
Develop an awareness of composition, scale and proportion  
Use paint mix or brush techniques to create texture  
Use sewing, applique and embroidery to create a picture

Experiment with batik techniques  
Learn about great artists, architects, craft makers and designers, and understand the historical and cultural development of their art forms.  
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
