- Locate and name the main counties and cities in England
- Develop use and understanding of latitude/longitude and the Greenwich Meridian and link this to work in science (Earth and Space)
- Compare the Southern region of the UK with a region in Europe i.e. an area with coast and ports (e.g. South of France) that has similarities and differences - this should also focus on change in the regions over time
- Describe and understand the features of coasts
- Carry out fieldwork in the wider and distant locality (coastal)
- Explore an aspect of trade between the UK and Europe
- Use 6 figure grid references confidently
- Give directions using eight cardinal points
- Can use agreed and Ordnance Survey symbols.
- Can make sketch maps of an area using symbols and key
- Carry out fieldwork in the locality
- Work with increasing confidence with: Large scale street maps and large scale Ordnance Survey maps (1:1250, 1:2500); aerial photographs, oblique and bird's eye views, games with maps and globes, Ordnance Survey maps 1:1250, 1:2500, 1:10 000, 1:25 000, 1:50 000
