## **LEGO Fortnite - PEGI 7**

Lego Fortnite is free to play (in app purchases are available though). The game has been rated as PEGI 7, meaning that the content is considered suitable for children over the age of 7. However you should also be aware that this game can be played with up to seven people, or solo. Lego Fornite is only accessible on Fortnite, so you must download the main game. When setting up an account, if your child is under the age of 13, they will be given a 'cabined account,' - certain features are disabled (such as communicating with other players) unless you override them.

Please ensure you set the parental controls as appropriate for your child, we also recommend setting the appropriate settings on the console itself. There are also two worlds available - Survival or Sandbox. You can find out more about each world
