English Writing

Our learning journeys this half term will be focused around the book 'Cogheart' written by Peter Bunzl. We are going to be studying this book over both of our learning journeys. Whilst reading this text, the children are going to be writing a diary entry, create a non-chronological report and become authors themselves by writing a narrative.

Reading

Children will be using VIPERS to teach our reading skills. Each lesson focuses on a different VIPER skill as the children read a variety of different books and poems. We will centre these lessons around a text of the week.
