



Uniform is worn at Portway Junior School to develop a sense of pride, identity and belonging in being a member of the school community. We believe that looking smart will help us to feel pride in who we are as a part of the Portway family and to take pride in all we do.

FOR SCHOOL UNIFORM:

- Portway Jumper / Cardigan
- Plain light blue polo shirt or Portway logo Polo shirt
- Plain black or grey dresses, skirts, trousers
- Plain black or grey shorts
- Blue checked dresses for girls
- Black school shoes
- Black or grey tights or white or dark socks for girls
- Dark socks for boys

FOR PE UNIFORM:

- Plain black or white trainers (for sports not fashion)

what do the children need?

For forest school, children need clothing that will keep them comfortable and protected in outdoor environments. This typically includes: waterproof clothing, warm layers, long sleeves and trousers and sturdy, waterproof boots or wellies. Dressing in layers helps adjust to changing weather throughout the day.



A letter will be sent home if your child is wearing incorrect uniform regularly






JEWELLERY:

- No jewellery to be worn due to health and safety reasons.
- Small plain studs in pierced ears, small watches (excluding smart watches) and small objects of religious significance are allowed.
- For safety reasons, the county stipulates that the wearing of earrings during PE lessons is forbidden.
- If a child cannot remove an earring it must be covered please provide your child with tape.
- Medical bracelets and medical necklaces are exempt from these rules.

MAKEUP AND HAIR:

- Make up (including nail varnish) is not permitted to be worn in school.
- Haircuts should be appropriate for school
- Hair accessories such as hair bands should be discreet e.g. no oversized bows, novelty headbands etc.





Spelling


In Year 4, we are teaching spelling using a bespoke approach suited to the year group.



Sounds and Syllables


We will dedicate time to the teaching of spelling in school - it will be taught 4 times every week.

Children will learn statutory words and be taught a wide range of spelling patterns supported by their knowledge of phonics.



• Times Tables

At Portway, we want to really engage the children so they enjoy and are excited to learn their tables. It is so beneficial to the children's maths if they are confident with finding multiplication and division number facts.



Our focus will initially be on learning strategies to recall times tables up to 12×12 .

This should be practiced at home using web games such as Times Table Rockstars.

(We use Times Table Rockstars - your child's login is their email address and their password is the same for each online learning platform. Found at the front of their diaries)






