#### English

Throughout this seven-week term, we'll delve into a variety of books that connect to our History focus on Ancient Egypt, including Marcy & The Riddle of the Sphinx by Joe Todd-Stanton, Pharaoh's Fate by C. Gautier and S. Vernet, and I Was There...Tutankhamun's Tomb by Sue Reid. In writing, we'll craft adventure narratives, explore mysteries, and consolidate our learning by creating a non-chronological report which will includes a diary, letter

Meanwhile, in reading, we'll further develop comprehension skills while examining the features of fiction and informational texts.
